I am writing today to request that you cosponsor the Uniting American Families Act, which would allow gays and lesbians to sponsor their partners and children for immigration. The Uniting American Families Act would allow a U.S. citizen or permanent resident to sponsor their same-sex partner for immigration benefits. Despite the guiding principle of “family unification” governing U.S. immigration policy, this benefit is currently denied to same-sex partnerships.

**As your constituent I ask that you take a stand for all families and cosponsor the Uniting American Families Act. U.S. immigration policy should live up to its promise to unite, not divide families.** If gay and lesbian families are left out of comprehensive immigration reform, the discrimination that forces bi-national gay and lesbian families apart or into exile will continue. Immigration reform is not comprehensive unless it includes all of families.
